The ruling is a bit wide, but not too crazy. Folds easily and has beautiful patterns. I would have given it 5 stars had a little more effort gone in to the production of the product. When I received this in the mail, the pages were clumped together where the adhesive was. A few tore while being separated, but most came out okay. Some of the layers of the single pages tore when removing one of the sheets. I'd recommend separating the pages by thumbing/flipping through the pages and gently sliding something between the pages that are still stuck together. I would also take all of the pages out of the

Really quite beautiful stationery. I do have two complaints: 1) It is not wrapped in plastic and it was tossed in a box with my other items. Bent pages are no fun. 2) The pages were stuck together where the side adhesives are. I was able to unstick them with minor damage. I am not sure yet if the adhesive is still good and know that I can use a glue stick but I found these to send overseas to the military folks. I don't know if glue sticks (or tape) are readily available but I could be wrong. They used to have them everywhere, but maybe I'm thinking it was back in the '70s. I'm surprised at how expensive this was, too, but if it's such a unique item anymore, then I guess it has to be. The lines are sufficient and the only thing that I don't like is I worry that when the receiver tears it open, that the whole letter will rip. Seems like they could have made the flaps larger and more sturdier. I think it would be difficult to open one of these without mangling if I got it in the mail, so I hesitate to use these very much. All in all, it is nice to have a tablet of this kind of stationery after all these years. I just don't know what happened and why they practically stopped manufacturing them for places like Walmart.
