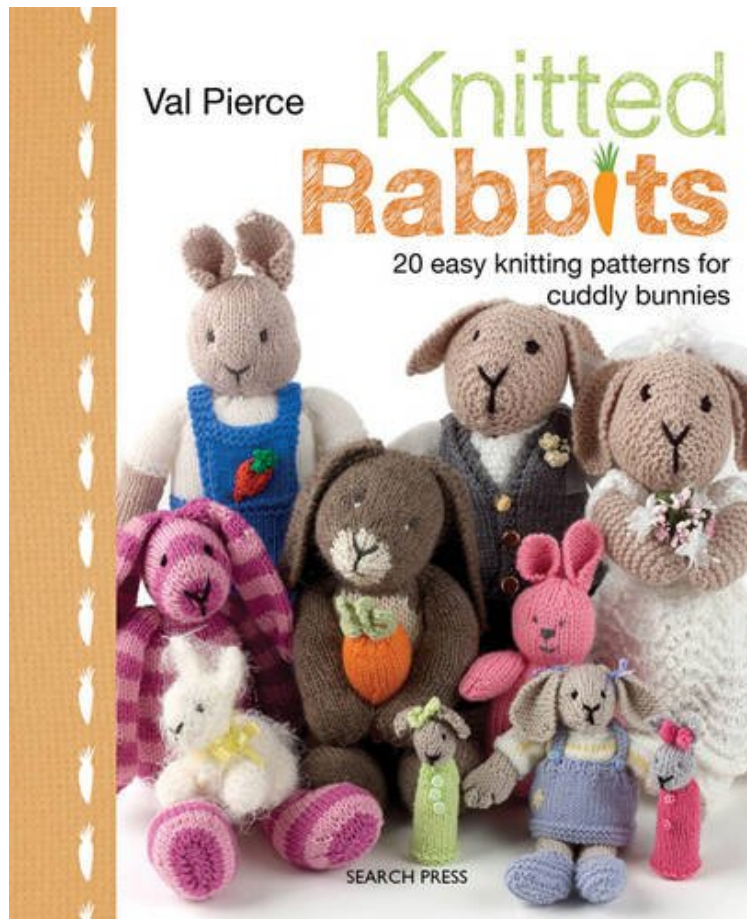

While I am a novice knitter and working on knitting the arms, I noticed that there are some math errors on the pattern that totally threw me off (page 60). I have 22 stitches on the needle currently and it says "Decrease for top of arm. Next Row: K2tog at each end of row (14sts). To me, if I started out with 22 on my needle, knitting 2 together ONLY at each end would produce the next row with 20 stitches, not 14. It's at the top of the arm which will be covered up and I just wrote down what I did so when I do the other arm it'll match. Hope it works out, it's part of a gift for a wedding we'll be attending.
