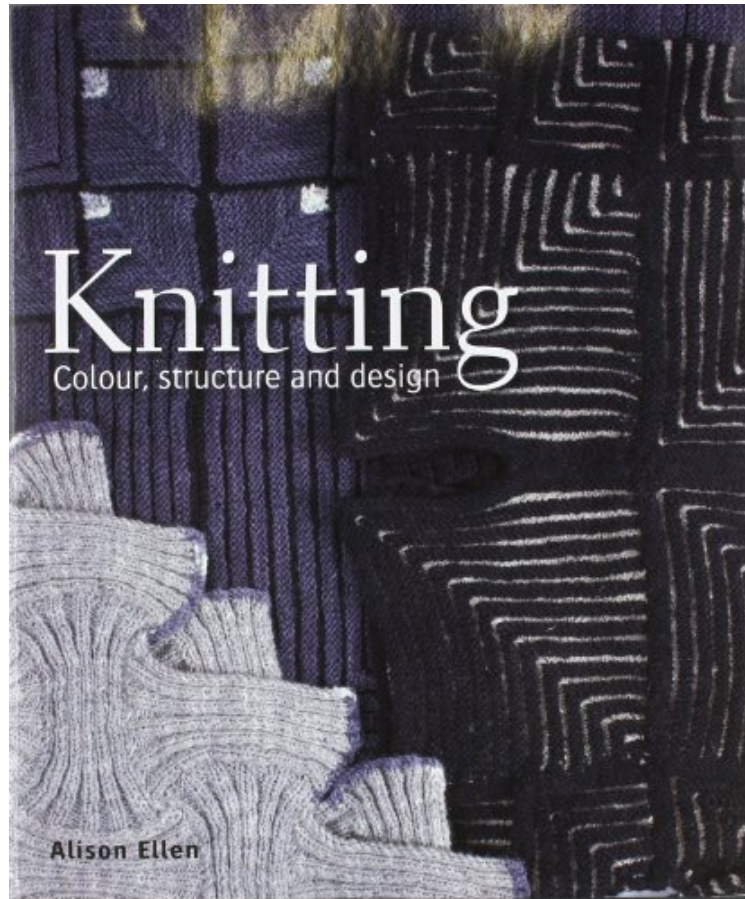

I have a knitting book collection, one of the books including Allison's Hand Knitting New Directions book. I recently bought this book only to see the same content and pictures from her Hand Knitting book. This book is lacking so much just like her other book, with hardly any pattern swatches. There is one page with a variety of attractive swatches showing color and stitch variations going in different directions,

but the rest of the pictures are sloppy samples in one color with the yarn tail still hanging from it! I was very disappointed in this book. While the author does write some good info in the book, its the same information from her previous book, even the chapters are the same, just worded a little differently. I get very little inspiration from this book, she could have put so much more into it. I would have really enjoyed a book filled with swatches in different color and stitch combinations going in various directions throughout the book to get my creative juices flowing and inspire me. This book definitely does not inspire! Authors really need to get creative and stop stealing people's money!
