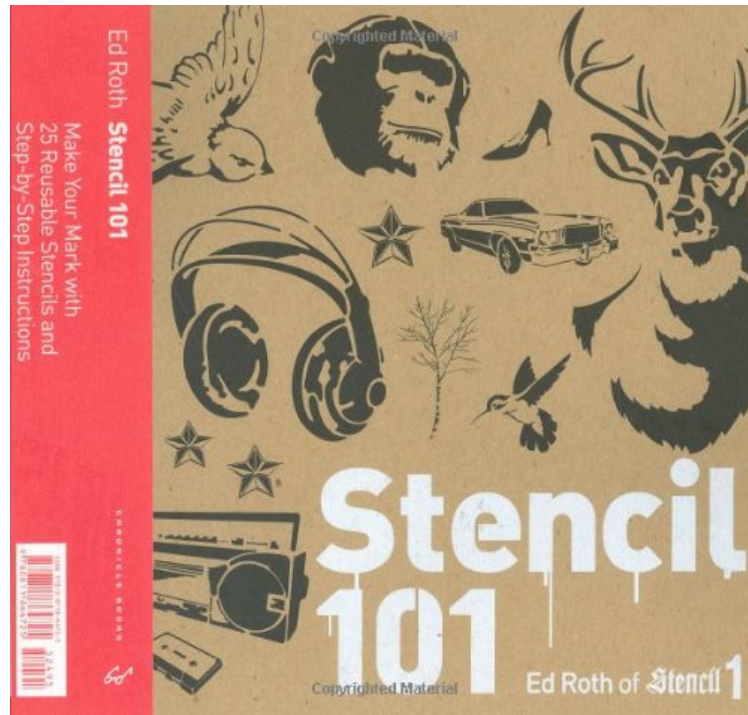

Reason I feel that way is the pages like other reviews noted are hard card stock paper which over time I can see become damaged by water or paint. Also the stencil are bonded into the binding and have to be torn out. The stencil are really a good mixture of items, but the shelf life is limited. I also bought the new 201 Stencil by same artist and now the stencils are made of light weight plastic and loose in the back of book. My sister told me to spray cards with protective sealant and I will try that on some to see if that prolongs the shelf life.
